**General Meeting May 6. 2019**

**Meeting was called to order by C. Steve at 7:32.**

**C. Steve introduced the Manson Apple Blossom Royalty, Queen Meagan Clausen and Princesses Perla Villaseñor and Marisol Mendoza. The chaperones for the royal court are Lonnie Buck and Heidi Griffith. The girls entertained us with a cute story they came up with. This is the 99<sup>th</sup> Apple Blossom Festival.**

**C. Steve introduced Robin Pittman from the Manson Parks and Vicki Downey swim instructor for the Parks and presented them with a check for \$2000.00 to help with the costs of keeping the free swim lessons going. Vicky stated that Manson is the only area on the lake that has a life guard on duty. She stated that she has been able to provide free swim lessons to anyone in the community because of donations such as this. She estimated she has been able to teach around 1000 kids to swim. The monies donated came from the Poker Run account.**

**C. Steve explained that approximately 1/3 of the net profits from the Poker Run are donated back to support the community. This year the board was able to donate an additional \$500 to the 4<sup>th</sup> of July fireworks, \$1000 for the scholarship fund, \$125 for the Manson beatification, \$125 towards the Rat Rods and \$1000 towards the Leffler Park proposal for a total of \$4750. This would not be possible if we did not have the support and hard work of the membership. Thank you.**

**Vicky Downey was introduced by Judy Steeles a prospective new member. Bill Jarr made a motion to waive the 30 day wait period, seconded by Cappy, motion carried. Welcome aboard. Rob and Nancy Robison were available for a vote, Cappy made a motion to accept them as new members, seconded by Dennis Rahm, motion carried. Welcome aboard.**

**C. Steve for a motion on the minutes from the April meeting that had been handed out. Nancy Redlin made a motion to accept as read, seconded by Harold Pittman, motion carried.**

**Cappy gave the following Treasurer's report. Checking: \$1199, PayPal: \$2041, Poker Run checking: \$6774, Club Savings: \$ 27488, Dock Savings: \$ 5188, Lucerne Savings: \$ 9526. Cappy also let the membership that members can now pay either through PayPal or Quick books right from the invoice. Bill made a motion to accept as read, seconded by Robin, motion carried.**

**The following reports were went over:**

**April 12<sup>th</sup> with the help of IMCO the ecology blocks along RR Creek were placed.**

**Lucerne Opening was a great success, everything got cleaned up, a new water tank was installed for the restrooms and shower, Dock work was accomplished on the down lake dock. Just need to place 6 braces and new decking and it will be ready to go back in place.**

**Clubhouse work party had about 10 people show up, they were able to get work done on the large gate between us and parks, nails hammered down, flagpole straighten and reinforced, the broken-down fire pit**

was removed, and gravel was raked in the parking lot. The signage, clubhouse inside, office and shed still need some attention.

C. Steve notified the membership that the board has approved a \$6000 budget for work in Driftwood Bay and another \$6000 for the docks at the clubhouse. Mark Redlin has agreed to head these projects.

Big thanks to Mark Redlin for agreeing to take these projects on, To Will Poppie for the excavator use in Driftwood Bay, Randy Baker for his great skills on the excavator, Gary Smitzen and Tom Zimmer for help with the barrier wall, Mark from Holden for the logs for the docks in Driftwood and for the fire wood that was delivered.

Fuel will be going up to Lucerne on the Wednesday run.

Jeannette asked that people take a look at the sign- up sheets for the 2019 Poker Run and to please sign up to help out in an area of your choosing. Bill announced that sponsorships are going well. If you would like to support the run this year or know of anyone to please contact him. C. Steve announced that our insurance policy that we have in place will cover the activities in downtown Manson Friday night of the Poker Run weekend. Mark your calendars for the Poker Run, July 12 – 14.

Cappy stated that help is needed Friday night for the street closure. He stated that closure signs were not available through the county so we will need to build some. Brett LeMar stated that he was willing to donate the materials needed to take on this project.

Bill announced that the Marine Patrol had 12 people use the clubhouse for educational and training purposes. Ryan Mooney was very happy with out facility and wanted to wish the club a very big Thank you.

There was no interest in participating in the parade. Dennis announced that he and Steve would be doing a live broadcast on Lake Chelan Now for the parade so take a listen. The ole guys are back together, ha-ha.

The drawing was held, and Dennis and Jeannette won and donated back to the membership.

Bill made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Cappy, motion carried.
